

CUBA AND ISCHUA, TOWNS OF—CONVEYANCE OF LANDS TO

CHAPTER 254

Approved and effective June 15, 1931

AN ACT to authorize the commissioner of general services to convey the right, title and interest of the people of the state in and to certain lands in the towns of Cuba, Allegany county and Ischua, Cattaraugus county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of general services in the executive department is hereby authorized to sell and convey to the towns of Cuba, Allegany county and Ischua, Cattaraugus county or Allegany and Cattaraugus counties or a special district wherein situated, in such parcels as the commissioner may determine, the lands generally described in section two of this act.

§ 2. All those lands in the county of Allegany, town of Cuba, township 3, range 2 and in the county of Cattaraugus, town of Ischua, township

3, range 3, situate north of Allegany county road no. 25; west of New York state route 305, south and west of Allegany county road no. 7 and south and east of Allegany county road no. 7D and the extensions of said roads in the town of Ischua, together with any lands of New York state contiguous thereto on the other side of said highways

being the premises known as the Cuba reservoir, lake or reservation and the Oil Creek reservoir.

§ 3. The commissioner of general services may fix and determine the terms and conditions of sale including the consideration to be paid by the town, county or special district which shall not be less than the fair market value thereof.

§ 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
